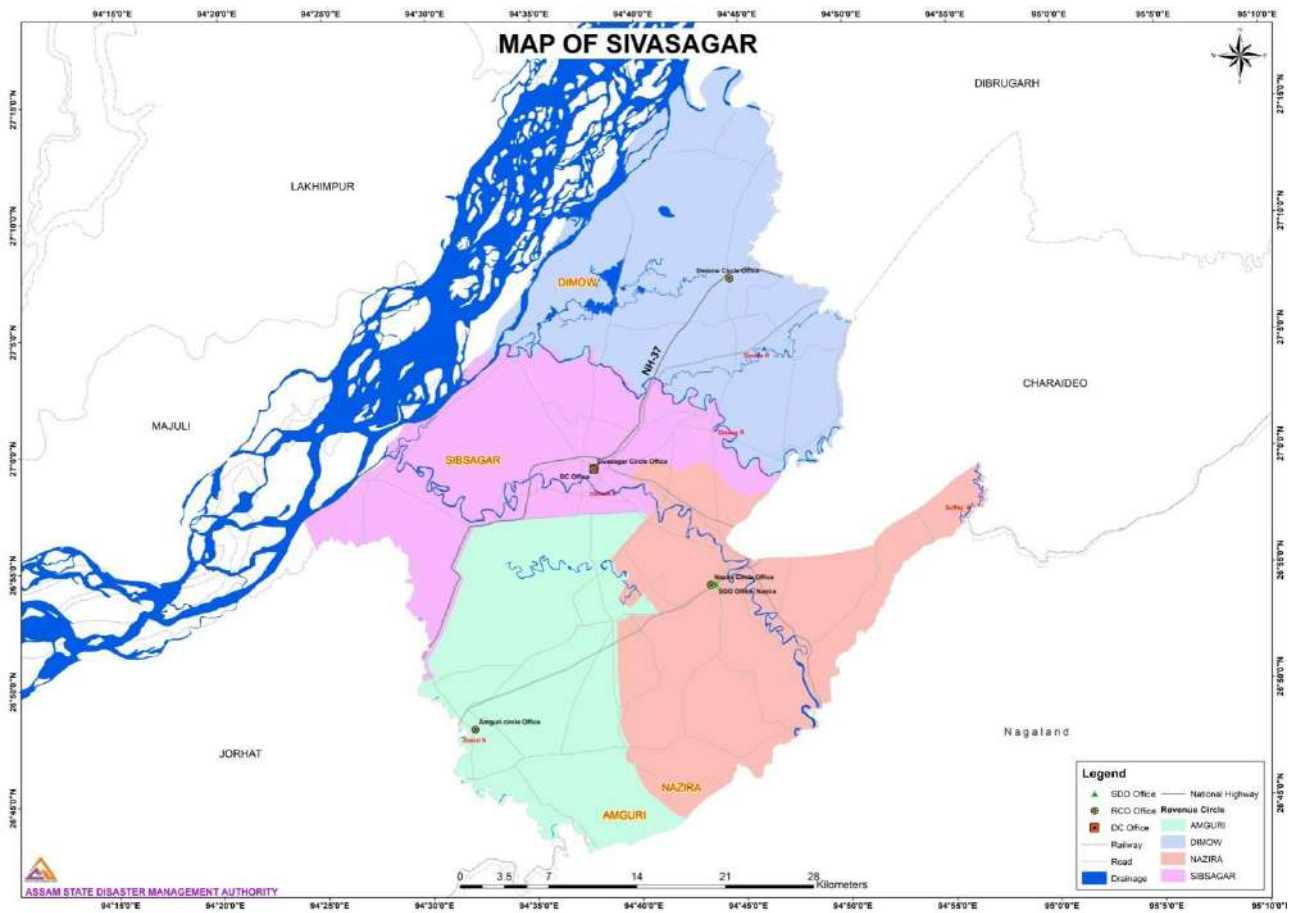

2. Introduction:

"Sivasagar" -earlier known as "Rangpur", the historical city of Assam is situated at a distance of 363 K.M. east of Guwahati (the capital of Assam). Earlier Sivasagar was the capital of the mighty Ahoms Kingdom, who ruled Assam for more than six hundred years before the advent of the British. The most remarkable landscape of the town is the 200 year old Sibsagar tank and many other historical monuments are located in the district. Modern Sibsagar is a fast-developing urban settlement. The district of Sibsagar is a leading tea and oil producing district of Assam. Sivasagar is situated between the coordinates of 21°45'N -27°15'N Latitude and 94°25'E - 95°25'E Longitude and at an elevation of 86.6 metres from mean sea level with average rainfall of **2060.56 mm (Last Five Year)**. It is one of the flood prone districts of Assam. Total area of the district is 1439.78sq. km. out of which 367. 3028sq. km. (25.51%) is flood prone. According to 2011 census Sivasagar had a population of 692435 nos. The Mighty Brahmaputra flows from East to West along with the northern boundary at a distance of 15 Km. from the Town. Other tributaries and sub-tributaries of Brahmaputra namely Dekhow, Dehing, Desang, Jhanji, Demow, Darika, Droi, Mitong are flowing through the district. It has been seen that the annual cycle of flood affects this district very badly. Considering the nature of the devastation of flood in previous years, this **Flood Management Plan** is prepared under District Disaster Management Authority with an objective of **“Zero Casualty”** to human life, lowering damages to properties and other livestock and better Relief Operation & Rehabilitation for the flood victims of the district.

The Flood Management plan covers all 4 (four) Revenue Circles (Sivasagar, Demow, Nazira and Amguri RCs) of the District.

3. History of Flood:

Every year the flood makes severe damages to the life and properties of the Riparian people of the district. Breach of Brahmaputra embankment occurred in the year 2012 at Dolopa area of Demow Rev. Circle and Deogharia area of Sivasagar Revenue Circle. Flash Flood generally observed at the adjoining area of Naga Hills of the District. In 2017, flash floods affected many villages in Amguri and Nazira Revenue Circle.

In an average 2 -3 waves of flood is experienced in the district mainly caused from River Brahmaputra and Desang, Dikhow and Dehing River. The most flood affected areas of the District may be identified as Dikhowmukh, Desangmukh and Dehingmukh.

4. Hazard, Risk and Vulnerability Analysis:

A. REASONS OF VULNERABILITY:

- Annual Rainfall: High intensity of Rainfall during the month of June- September in Sivasagar and upstream areas, adjoining States i.e. Arunachal Pradesh, Nagaland.
- The occurrence of flood in the district happens from the river Brahmaputra and its tributaries and sub-tributaries.
- The district is located on the banks of the mighty Brahmaputra. Erosion to the agricultural land/ River Bank, sedimentation in the riverbed of Brahmaputra lowering the carrying capacity of the river and makes flooded its catchment areas.
- Dense population in the flood prone areas, outside the embankment areas.

6. Flood Early Warning System (FLEWS):

Flood Early Warning (FLEW) System followed by ASDMA and DDMA during last flood season is one of the successful tools in respect of reducing the damages of flood. With vital and predicted information on rainfall in Assam as well as nearby state of Arunachal Pradesh etc. and information of water level in the rivers of Assam helped the administration to take initiatives before the last flood in Sivasagar District. ASDMA with the help of NESAC, IMD, RMC and CWC send forecasted information of rainfall and danger level of rivers to Flood Control Room of Sivasagar and other concerned officers through email and SMS. After receiving the information immediate meeting was called by DDMA and directed all Circle Officers and line Deptts. to be ready to tackle the situation. Thus, flood FLEW system helped DDMA, Sivasagar to reduce the loss of life and assets during last flood seasons.

Now DDMA Sivasagar is adopting policies to bring the FLEW system to village level. List of villages with Village Heads & their phone numbers are prepared for entire district so that the warning of flood can be communicated from Circle/Block Offices to each villages at an early time.

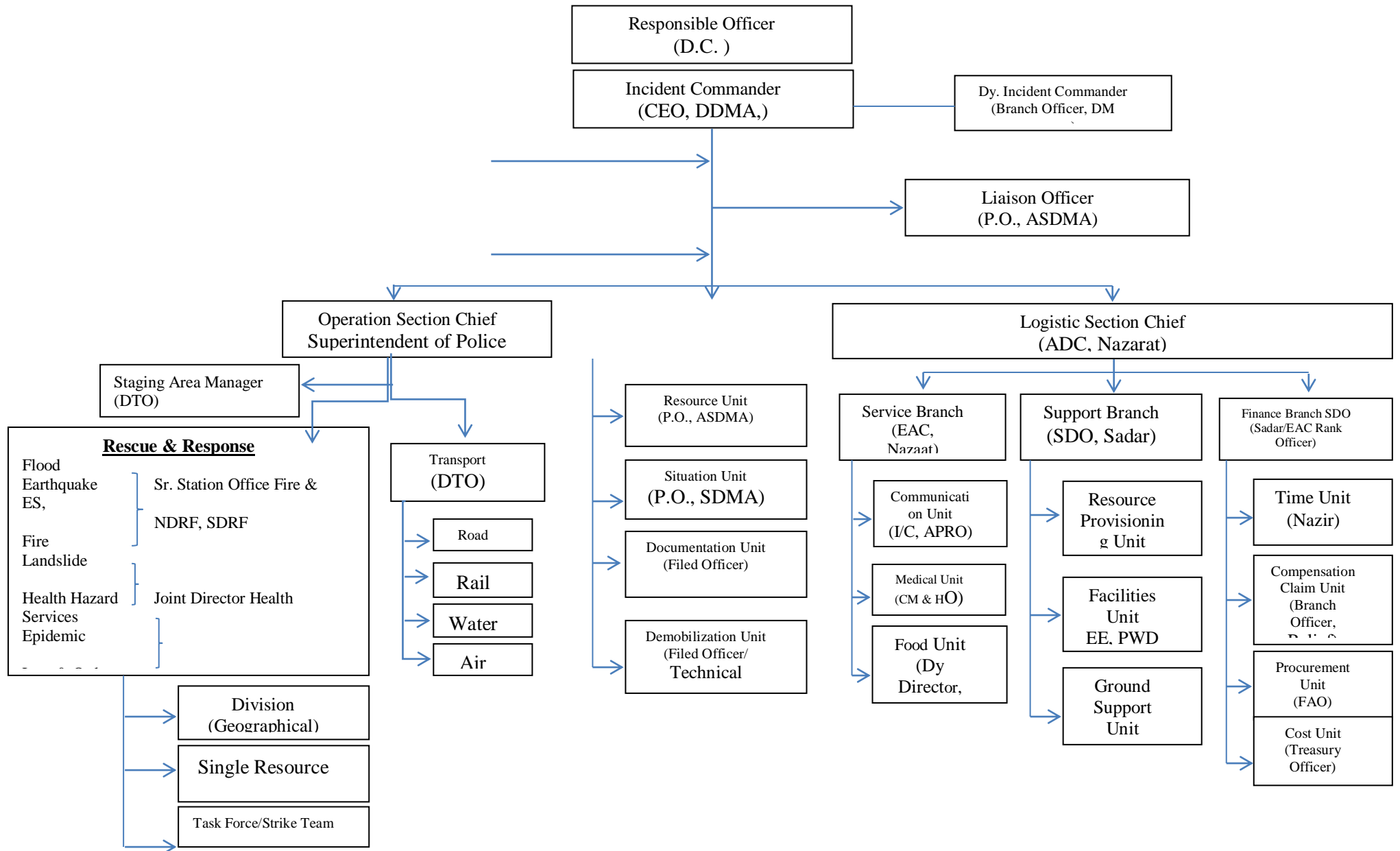
7. District Level Incident Response System (IRS): (As per Govt. Guidelines)

The Incident Response System (IRS) is a management system and an on-scene, all-risk, flexible modular system adaptable for natural as well as man-made disasters. The IRS has a number of attributes or system features. Because of these features, IRS has the flexibility and adaptability to be applied to a wide variety of incidents and events both large and small. The primary IRS management functions include:

- ◆ Command
- ◆ Operations
- ◆ Logistics
- ◆ Planning
- ◆ Finance / Administration

The ICS seeks to strengthen the existing disaster response management system by ensuring that the designated controlling/responsible authorities at different levels are backed by trained Incident Response Teams (IRTs) whose members have been trained in the different facets of disaster response management.

The DEOC in Sivasagar District was set up as per direction of ASDMA in Feb, 2015 and has been running in 24 x 7 basis. Following the important three *C's* i.e. Command, Control and Communication for effective response in *emergency*, the Authority will be able to minimize the hardships of the community and improve the quality of the process of recovery.

The District Emergency Operation Centre under the control of District Commissioner, Sivasagar will operate round the clock and will be the *nerve* centre to.

Annexure: VIII (Flood Safety Tips)

This guide lists simple things you and your family can do to safely and protect your property from floods.

Before flooding occurs

- Your entire family member should know the safe route to nearest shelter/raised pucca house.
- If your area is flood-prone, consider alternative building materials. Mud walls are more likely to be damaged during floods. You may consider making houses where the walls are made of local bricks up to the highest known flood level with cement pointing.
- Have an emergency kit on hand which includes a:
 - A portable radio, torch and spare batteries.
 - Stocks of fresh water, dry food (chura, mudi, gur, biscuits), kerosene, candle and matchboxes.
 - Waterproof or polythene bags for clothing and valuable an umbrella and bamboo stick (to protect from snakes), salt and sugar.
- A first aid kit, manual and strong ropes for tying things.

When you hear a flood warning or if flooding appears likely

- Tune to your local radio / TV for warnings and advice.
- Keep vigil on flood warning and advice.
- Don't give any importance to rumours and don't panic
- Keep dry food, drinking water and clothes ready.
- Prepare to take bullock carts, other agricultural equipments, and domestic animals to safer places or to higher locations.
- Place which indoor items you will raise or empty if water threatens to enter your house
- Check your emergency kit.

During floods

- Drink boiled water.
- Keep your food covered, don't take heavy meals.
- Use raw tea, rice-water, tender coconut-water, etc. During diarrhoea; contact your ANM/AWW for ORS and treatment.
- Do not let children remain on empty stomach.
- Use bleaching powder and lime to disinfect the surrounding.
- Help the officials/volunteers distributing relief materials.

If you need to evacuate

- Firstly pack warm clothing essential medication, valuable, personal paper, etc. in waterproof bags, to be taken with your emergency kit.
- Take the emergency kit.
- Inform the local volunteers (if available), the address of the place you are evacuating to.
- Raise furniture, clothing and valuables onto beds, tables and to the top of the roof (electrical items highest).
- Turn off power.
- Whether you leave or stay put sandbags in to the toilet bowl and over all laundry/ bathroom drains-holes to prevent sewage back-flow.
- Lock your home and take recommended/know evacuation routes for your area.
- Do not get into water of unknown depth and current.

If you stay or on your return

- Stay tuned to local radio for updated advice.
- Do not allow children to play in or near flood water.
- Avoid entering floodwaters. If you must, wear proper protection for your feet and check depth and current with a stick. Stay away from drains, culverts and water over knee-deep.
- Don't use electrical appliances, which have been in flood water until checked for safety.
- Do not eat food, which has been in floodwaters.
- Boil tap water (in cities) until supplies have been declared safe. In case of rural areas, store tube well water in plastic jars or use halogen tablets before drinking.
- Be careful of snakes, snakebites are common during floods.
